

## Relay Leg 2 Ashnola (Centennial Trail) 7 km/4 miles

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### Start--Ashnola River Road

Start at Wall Creek Bridge on Ashnola River Road. This bridge is 50 km from Hwy 3 near Keremeos and at the 38 km tree marker on Ashnola River Road. Markers on road indicate gravel road distances for pine beetle logging trucks. Centennial Trail comes down to this bridge from Cathedral Provincial Park. If doing this trail before race day, we recommend that you use GPS file downloaded from TrailHunger site. On race day, it will be well flagged.

### Centennial Trail

- Exchange at the aid station.
- Head along Ashnola River Road.
- Follow the road until you come to V-fork.



- Take RIGHT fork. Look for immediate right (➡) hand turn (at sign shown in this photo, flagged) onto Centennial. There is a signpost there.
- On trail, veer left, go through trees and reach another forest service road.
- Turn LEFT a few meters to **first curve** in road.
- Watch for stakes/flagging leading up bank on your right. (🚧)
- Follow switchback.
- Come to burned out forest.



- Good running stream at about 5 km.



**Trapper Aid Station** will be just before the big Easy Going sign, 7 km from Ashnola River Road. Relay exchange here.
